How can one help amputees?

1. 1,000 baht is enough to provide a below knee farmer leg.
2. 1,500 baht is enough to provide a below knee cosmetic leg for social functions, thus improving quality of life.
3. 2,500 baht is enough to provide both of these for a farmer.
4. 8,000 baht is enough to provide an above knee artificial leg.
5. 12,000 baht is enough to provide a hip disarticulation artificial leg.

they will have a better life”

The majority of Thai citizens are farmers living in the countryside and rural areas. They are poor and unable to afford artificial legs, even from government hospitals which are relatively cheap. The artificial legs are essential for improving the quality of their lives and enabling them to work as normal people.

Prosthesis Foundation of H.R.H. The Princess Mother has a mobile prosthetic unit for use in rural remote areas to make artificial legs free of charge for poor and disabled amputees. The Foundation has volunteers, doctors and technicians to make artificial legs all year round.

One way you can help them is by donating money to The Prosthesis Foundation thus sharing in the aims of foundation.

History of The Prosthesis Foundation

Prosthesis Foundation of H.R.H. The Princess Mother was established in 1992, when it was learned that Dr.Therdchai Jivacate was able to make artificial legs which were lighter, more comfortable and 10 times less expensive than imported ones, since they were made from recycled plastic. The Princess Mother set up The Prosthesis Foundation to provide free artificial legs for poor amputees, regardless of nationality or religion.



The Prosthesis Foundation was Registered on Aug. 17, 1992 with the Princess Mother as Honorary Chairman and H.R.H. Princess Galayani Vadhana Kronluang Naradhi-was Rajanagarindra as President. Both donated a sum of money which made it possible for the Foundation to begin providing artificial legs in 1992.

Aims of The Foundation

1. To provide free artificial legs for amputees, regardless of nationality or religion.
2. To provide prosthetic parts for workshops which can make and repair the same type prostheses as the Foundation's without charge.
3. To provide other aids for daily living such as crutches, canes or walkers, that make possible for the disabled to work.
4. To train prosthetists in hospitals or medical centers to make the Foundation's type prostheses and to increase their skills and knowledge.
5. To continue research which will improve the Foundation's prostheses.
6. To work for the public's welfare and co-operate with other organization that provide public service
